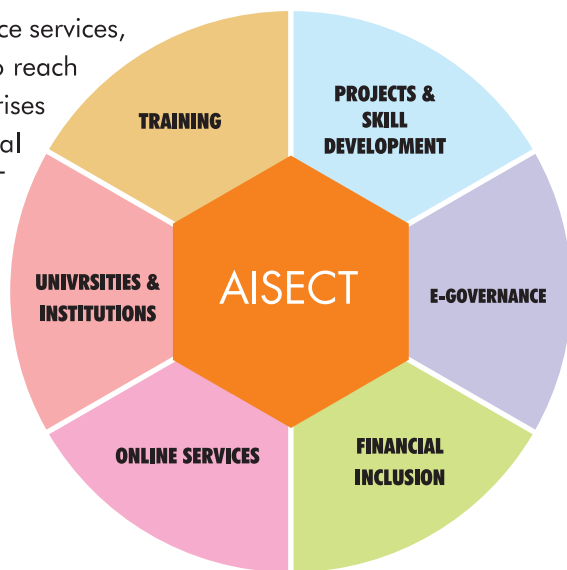


ABOUT AISECT

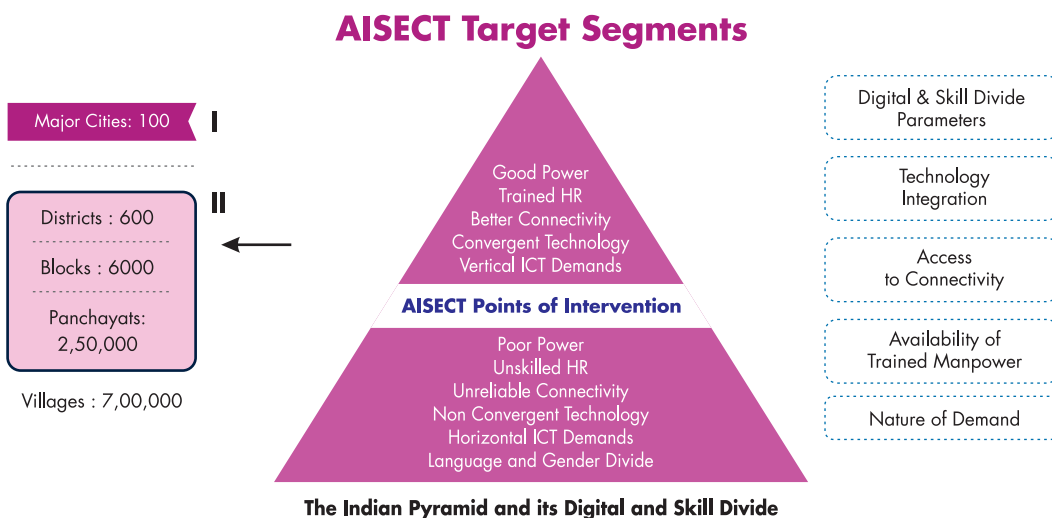

Skill Development and Vocational Education :

AISECT has been working in the field of skill development and training for the past 31 years and have reached the remotest corners of the country. It is a pioneer in imparting skill development courses in local language which explains its reach at the grassroots. AISECT's reach within the country is aptly showcased through a Demographic Pyramid whereby the penetration of AISECT's various activities is highest at the bottom.

AISECT – NSDC Partnership:

AISECT joined hands with NSDC with the mission to skill around 1.3 million youth across rural and semi-urban India in 2012, in seven of the twenty-one priority sectors identified by NSDC. The seven sectors identified by AISECT for training the youth are IT and ITES, Electronics and Hardware, Banking and Financial Services, Teacher and Assessor Training, Textiles, Organised Retail and Agri skills. These are the sectors which are estimated to have the highest contribution towards the requirement of skilled workforce in the country over next ten years. Under this partnership AISECT has also been affiliated with 18 Sector Skill Councils formed under NSDC.

The main objectives of this partnership were :

- To expand the skilling and training facilities of AISECT, first in the rural and backward regions of states such as Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Bihar, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Orissa, Maharashtra and Punjab and then expand across the country.
- To undertake massive “Training of Trainers” program to improve the quality of skill training and to up skill the technology utilization of trainers in training.
- To utilize the nearly 6,000 Common Service Centres (CSCs) set up by AISECT at the Panchyat Level across Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh & Punjab for skilling youth.
- To link skill development programs with university education and to set up Vocational Academies or Skill Resource Centers within the two AISECT Universities.
- To support the skill development training programs by providing placement services both online and offline to the trained manpower.
- To expand and develop the AISECT Content Creation Center as the backbone of the ongoing skill development efforts.

Higher Education :

A path-breaker in the field of ICT and skill-based education and training, AISECT has positively empowered millions of lives through their educational initiatives over the last 33 years. The Group has established several premier higher education institutions at locations which were in dire need of quality higher education institutions. In 2006, Dr. C. V. Raman University, central India's first private university, was established in Chhattisgarh and has empowered thousands of students with industry-oriented skills. Moreover, India's first skill-based private University, Rabindranath Tagore University, Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh strives to impart skill-based quality education and promote research driven advancement of knowledge for creating successful professionals. Established by the AISECT Group in 2010, it has carved a niche for itself in Madhya Pradesh. This need of imparting skill based higher education motivated to established AISECT University, Jharkhand, Dr. C. V. Raman University, Bihar and Dr. C. V. Raman University, Madhya Pradesh. Furthermore, SCOPE Group of Institution (SCOPE College of Engineering and SCOPE College of Education) has been established in Bhopal. With strong industry linkages, AISECT's focus lies in the holistic learning and development of a student in order to ensure the effective application of knowledge for a secure future.



AISECT School Services :

AISECT's rich experience in the education sector has led to the establishment of a series of educational ventures, Brainy Bear Activity Club & Pre-School, Brainy Bear Publications and multimedia school content for students from kindergarten to class 12th that provides cost-effective, interactive learning solution to children.

AISECT has successfully integrated itself in the pre-school segment by establishing Brainy Bear Pre-school and Activity Club chain, aimed at providing first-of-its-kind affordable pre-schooling chain in tier 2 and 3 cities. It has also included other programs like, Mother Toddler Program and After School Program. AISECT's pre-schooling chain in the rural areas was initiated as Brainy Bear Prarambh. With over 16 centres launched within 1 year, AISECT's Brainy Bear Pre-school and Activity Club chain has successfully enrolled more than 500 students in an attempt to provide affordable and quality early childhood education to students of semi-urban and rural India.



Online Education :

Giving shape to AISECT's endeavor to support the Skill India and Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan movements, aisectmoocs.com was established as India's largest free online open learning platform. AISECT in association with Ireland-based ALISON, offers inclusivity in education by giving students in the remotest corners of the country easy and free access to world-class course curriculum with over 2000 free certificate/diploma courses available in both English and Hindi. In a blended model students enrolled for an AISECT MOOC course will have the choice of studying at home or coming to the AISECT Centre to make use of the available facilities.

AISECT has also launched a portal 'aisectionline.com' to empower students in the remotest corners of the country with anywhere, anytime access to education.

AISECT has also initiated concentrated efforts in various B2C services such as mobile and DTH recharge, examination form download and submission, railway ticket booking, data entry operations etc., to make such services more accessible to the common man by integrating with government departments, private businesses and other organizations.



Financial Inclusion and e-Governance Services :

Keeping in mind the urgent need for Financial Inclusion in the country, AISECT has successfully established a Financial Inclusion model that has been synchronizing more and more services through the AISECT's Multi-purpose ICT enable centres in rural areas. AISECT has set up over 4000 banking kiosks in association with 3 nationalized banks and 2 regional rural banks with 88 lakh accounts opened so far and transactions worth Rs. 5000 crores, initiated mobile ATM services, and started offering renewal premium collection services for reputed insurance companies.

AISECT's prestigious Common Service Centre Project, under the Government of India, was a resonating success and led to the establishment of 2926 CSCs in Madhya Pradesh, 1487 in Chhattisgarh and 585 CSCs in Punjab. Apart from AISECT's core education, training & B2C services, these CSCs provided services under schemes like Jan Sunwai Kendra, Farmer Registration, PFRDA, MP Online, National Population Register, MNREGA, PAN Card as well as Suidhaa Online. The AISECT's CSCs in M.P, Chhattisgarh and Punjab also functioned as the permanent UID (Aadhar) Card Enrolment Centres. Recently AISECT has also established 300 E-Mitra Kiosks in Rajasthan which are providing government services to the citizens



Placement :

Focused on bridging the demand and supply gap in the job market, AISECT has established India's biggest rural job portal, Rojgar Mantra. Rojgarmantra.com is a one-of-a-kind job portal focused on providing relevant employment opportunities and related services to the job seekers while at the same time providing a medium for employers to recruit suitable skilled and semi skilled manpower. With over 3 lakh job seekers already registered with the portal, Rojgar Mantra is poised to be the biggest rural job placement initiative of India.

Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKK)

India is one of the youngest nations in the world with around 62% of its population in the working age group (15-59 years) and more than 54% of the total population is below 25 years of age. The nation will have the biggest manpower resource by 2020 with an average age of 29 years as against 40 years in USA, 46 years in Europe and 47 years in Japan. A need for 109.73 million skilled manpower by 2022, in twenty four key sectors, indicates that skills and knowledge will play an important role in shaping this manpower pool in India, in turn contributing to economic growth and social development of the country.

Realising the importance of skills in the times to come, the first National Policy on Skill Development was notified in 2009. In the aftermath of this policy, National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) was established in 2009, to promote private sector participation via innovative funding models. Further in 2014, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship was formed to drive the efforts of skill development in the country. This followed with the launch of revised National Policy on Skill Development and Entrepreneurship to boost the skill ecosystem in India. This policy aims at converging all the skill development activities going on in the country and standardising them with common norms. It also envisages to form an institutional framework which will then drive all such initiatives in future.

As one of the initiatives to standardise skill development, MSDE aims at setting up visible and aspirational skill development training centres in every district which are called Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras. These are state-of-the-art training centres established through Public Private Partnerships between NSDC and training partners. The model training centres envisage to:

- Create benchmark institutions that demonstrate aspirational value for competency based skill development training
- Focus on elements of quality, sustainability and connect with stakeholders in skills delivery process
- Transform from a mandate driven footloose model to a sustainable institutional model

The Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) is a huge step in establishing a model and iconic centre of excellence for skill development with the vision of making India, the “Skill Capital of the World”.

Approach for Centre Establishment :

Under this scheme, NSDC has followed a cluster wise approach for centre establishment. Three categories of PMKK centres are determined based on district population. Each category has different minimum area requirements for PMKK centres as depicted in the table below:

S.No.	Category of Centre	District Population (for the age group 15-35 years)	Minimum area Proposed (in sqft)

AISECT Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras

AISECT, an NSDC training partner, has been assigned with four clusters in two states, Chhattisgarh and Madhya Pradesh in its Phase-1 for setting up of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras. **These clusters are MP-1, MP-9, CG-3 and CG-4 which have a total of 23 districts. Therefore AISECT has been allotted a total target of setting up 23 PMKs.**

NSDC is supervising this project and thus is acting as a network manager, where it shall strive to provide the necessary support system in TP empanelment, MIS, Finance and other support like branding, content, etc. For setting up the PMKK centre, NSDC provides funding in the form of a loan to cover 70% of its expenditure at an applicable rate of interest with a repayment period of 4 years. The loan is capped at a maximum limit of 70 lakhs per centre and will be utilised for infrastructure, training aids and internal renovation.

The process before operationalizing any PMKK in the district, follows 2 steps – location sign off and centre sign off. When the location of the centre is approved (location sign off), the construction work according to the classrooms and labs take place. The ready centres are then assigned with job role wise mandate, to start the training in the centre (centre sign off).

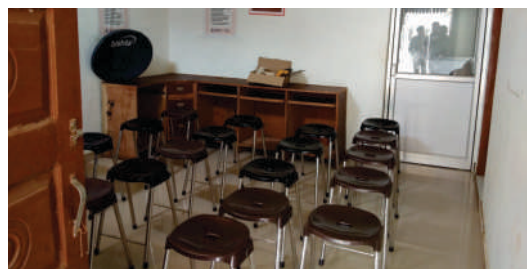

AISECT in Phase – 4 of PMKK

In the month of April 2018, NSDC started the fourth phase of the allotment of the remaining aspirational districts to the Training Providers for establishing the PMKKs. With the announcement of the allotments, AISECT formed a high level committee to take care of due diligence, location sign off till the PMKKs get functional.

The AISECT was allotted with 12 districts in Phase-4. The allotment enlisted Kanpur Dehat, Jhansi, Azamgarh, Chitrakoot, Jalaun, Lucknow and Bijnor in Uttar Pradesh; Bhind and Morena in Madhya Pradesh; Bhagalpur in Bihar; Lohardaga in Jharkhand and Salem in Tamil Nadu. The district of Kondagaon in Chhattisgarh was also allotted to AISECT for establishing the non-funded PMKK on Spoke model. For keeping the process of Phase-4 streamlined up to making the PMKKs functional, the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) is already chalked out, which is a very practical document.

Activities at AISECT PMKKs

1. International Yoga Day, 21st June, celebrated at AISECT-PMKKs

Yoga refers to the union and not as an idea or a concept that we understand. It gives us the sense to realize our body and rejuvenate ourselves. The philosophy, that is Yoga, is a gift from India to the entire world. Three years back, the United Nations proposed to mark 21st June as the International Yoga Day. Almost all 172 countries of the globe immediately endorsed the idea.

We at AISECT, celebrate the International Yoga Day at all functional PMKKs, Regional and State offices and PMKVY centres. The idea behind it is the same, i.e. to realize the core of Yoga that is Karma with commitment and zeal. In all our functional PMKKs- Shahdol, Anuppur, Raipur, Mungeli, Durg, Bemetara, Narayanpur, Ashoknagar, Bhopal, Raisen, Sehore and Bilaspur, all candidates, admin staff and trainers participated in Yogasanas and Pranayams.

A large number of participants, approximately 800 from AISECT PMKKs, 850 participants from regional and state offices of AISECT and 650 participants from AISECT-PMKVY centres, participated in this programme last year. The day started with warm up and stretching exercises. Then, participants performed various asanas and deep breathing exercise called pranayams. These all were followed by DRT (Deep Relaxation Technique). The feeling was very refreshing, which made the participants energized.



2. Guest Lectures :

AISECT- PMKKs have also tied up with potential employers and industry experts at the locations where registrations have started. The relevant personnel from these organisations are called to PMKKs to deliver a lecture on industry environment, their requirements from the potential employees and how the training being conducted at these centres are beneficial for the participants. This helps the candidates to understand the work environment and job requirement in the organisations and make up their mind as to their choice of organisation, where they would want to build their career.



3. Kaushal Melas at PMKKs :

Successful placements is one of the important outcomes of the training conducted at PMKKs. Every AISECT- PMKK has a placement officer, who is constantly involved in tying up with relevant employers for the job roles which are being conducted. After associating with such employers, Kaushal Mela (job fair) is conducted at PMKK premises for candidates who have been certified. This Kaushal Mela acts as a platform, where the employers can choose from a pool of certified candidates and the candidates also have the opportunity to choose the best according to their skills set. Thus, it is a win-win situation for both. These Kaushal Melas have become a regular event and are conducted at all PMKKs. A large number of companies have participated in this event.



4. Skill Saathi – career counselling campaign towards a bright future :

India is the youngest country in the world. We have 2.59 crore youth turning 15 years of age, every year. This is a very big number and is expected to increase in the next decade or so. This gives us an opportune demographic dividend, one which could fuel the Indian economy. The challenge though is, to ensure that our youth is suitably skilled. It's a big challenge, since nearly 1.2 crore youth drop out of the formal education system.

Skill Saathi, i.e. National Counselling Campaign 2018, is the campaign initiated by NSDC, in association with Counselling Implementing Organization or Training Partners, with a view of making young generation in the society aware of various initiatives and projects of training and placement by the Govt. of India. The main objective of Skill Saathi Campaign 2018, is to facilitate awareness and guidance among the candidates about the available courses in PMKKs as per their aptitude and psychometric test results and availability of skill training prospects.

The workshop on Skill Saathi, organized by the NSDC on 26th November 2018, in the auditorium of Rabindranath Tagore University, Bhopal, for all the TPs, including AISECT in MP. The representatives of various TPs, attended the one-day long workshop and were made to understand the process of National Counselling Campaign.

Dr. Archana Singh from NSDC, New Delhi, conducted the workshop and imparted several points.

Skill Saathi career counselling one-day workshop was conducted on 10th of December 2018, in the premises of AISECT- PMKK Durg, under the supervision of Utpal Kumar from NSDC, New Delhi and Pritish Behra, SEO NSDC (CG). All the TPs from CG including AISECT were invited to take part in the workshop, to understand the objectives and know how to counsel the youth on various Skill Development projects, initiated by the Govt. of India.



5. Mudra Loan Facilitation at AISECT :

MUDRA Loan is provided under the Pradhan Mantri MUDRA Yojana (PMMY) to non-farming and non-corporate micro and small enterprises. These enterprises can avail loans up to Rs.10 Lakh under the MUDRA (Micro Units Development & Refinance Agency Ltd.) scheme.

Role of NSDC

NSDC has initiated Mudra Loan collaboration with Small Industries Development Bank of India (SIDBI). The TPs which are implementing managers of PMKVY scheme through Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs) are termed as the Hand Holding Agencies and are made responsible for selecting the candidates who aspire to start their own unit as the entrepreneurs.

Role of AISECT as the Hand Holding Agency

AISECT PMKKs as the Hand holding agency have the following tasks to pursue before a candidate is provided with the Mudra Loan.

1. Identifying aspirant entrepreneurs, helping them to draft the blue print of their business ideas
2. Counseling the candidates on start ups
3. Paper formalities for developing the project files
4. Filling up and committing the online applications at centre level for Shishu Loans where Project Report is not mandatory
5. After submission the application, reaching out the concerned Banks in the vicinities and submitting offline applications
6. Providing the detailed list of concerned LDM, Banks RO/ZO
7. Systematic approach to LDM, Regional or Zonal offices of concerned Bank with candidates
8. A uniform reporting system for reporting the Application details to NSDC

AISECT PMKKs Efforts

AISECT PMKKs have successfully registered more than 2200 candidates as of now on SIDBI portal. In continuation, PMKKs have been helping in preparing Project Files for registered candidates and approaching to the banks.

A distinct workshop on Mudra Loan got organized by AISECT on 6th of February 2019 in its Head Office, Bhopal, where Center Heads of 23 PMKKs participated in. The hand holding approach of the workshop made the Center Heads much confident with the algorithm of the process.



Best Practice of AISECT PMKKs

1. AISECT-PMKK Kaushal Vikas Yatra :

One of the key challenges faced by many organizations working in the field of skill development is the effective mobilization of trainees. In fact, mobilisation forms the foundation of the entire skilling value chain for any trainee. Over the past several years, working in the unorganized sector and rural and semi-urban parts of the country for skill development, AISECT has earned rich experience in mobilisation of candidates for vocational training.

The practice of conducting 'Kaushal Vikas Yatra' is a highly successful trainee mobilisation process. This practice has now evolved into a ground level trainee activation campaign. The Kaushal Vikas Yatra (KVY) provides an extensive coverage of districts and blocks, and takes the message and benefits of the project of PMKK closer to the youth.

The KVV is formulated with the basic objective of spreading awareness on the project of PMKK for the job-seekers in the districts, especially for the rural citizens. The model of this campaign includes a van or any of the suitable four-wheelers, specifically designed for the purpose and equipped with campaign materials. The decoration with proper flexes, makes these vehicles distinct. The vehicle moves through already defined routes in the district, carrying the mobiliser and the supporting staff with Centre Heads, who communicate with the people on the project and its benefits. In fact, it is the process of sensitising the masses.

AISECT's experience shows that ground level activation campaigns, which can reach the trainees directly, are one of the most effective ways of awareness generation and recall for courses. AISECT-PMKK Kaushal Vikas Yatra was conducted in the desired location which was a simultaneous process carried out with setting up the PMKK centre. This has helped in effective mobilisation of trainees and increased number of registrations in the PMKK centres.

2. Industry visits by candidates of AISECT- PMKKs :

AISECT not only focuses on skilling the youth but also the process is implemented in such a way that candidates are made familiar with today's scenario at workplace. It is done by providing them industry visits before they start attending OJT sessions after theoretical training.

We at AISECT- PMKK, introduce our candidates to the industries of different fields for better perception and clear idea about their future. This initiative makes the candidates even more comfortable in their career and makes them apt and job ready to the particular industry by realising the real time experiences.



3. AISECT Kaushal Championship 2018 :

World Youth Skills Day (WYSD) is celebrated every year on 15th of July. This year, AISECT PMKKs celebrated the WYSD with a view of showcasing the skills of the trainees. AISECT has been in the sector of skill training for the last 33 years. 'AISECT Kaushal Championship' was started this year on the occasion of WYSD at AISECT-PMKKs and was kept 'Open to All'. The first leg of the championship ended with the announcement of the first three candidates from each job roles in respective PMKKs. The second and third leg of the championship was conducted at the



State level and National level, respectively. National Level Kaushal Championship 2018, was organized in the picturesque lush-green premises of Rabindranath Tagore University (RNTU, MP) on 25th October 2018.

The championship witnessed the participation of over 7,000 students in the age group of 18 to 35 years in 5 different trades, i.e. Data Entry and proficiency in MS-Office, Domestic Electrician, Arc Welding, Tailoring and Computer Hardware. Participants were from 8 states, namely, Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Punjab and Jharkhand.

4 Field survey in the catchment areas of aspirational districts :

Over the past several years, working for the unorganized sector, rural and semi-urban parts of the country for skill development, AISECT has earned a rich experience in mobilisation, which helps us in taking initiatives of implementing PMKK Field Surveys. AISECT selects the catchment areas in the districts based on various parameters and the team goes for door to door counselling, which gives us the opportunity to filter every household in the vicinity. This initiative has provided us with the real and genuine candidates for these trainings programmes.



5. Parent/Guardian meeting in PMKK :

We at AISECT- PMKK, understand that mobilisation and counselling the youth are very important aspects of PMKK project. But, it is more important to make their Parents/Guardians aware about what their wards are getting skilled into, in the PMKKs. The discussion in the meeting with Parents/Guardians, at least once in a month, makes the candidates more attentive and serious during pursuing the courses. The Parents/Guardians do get exposed to the 'state- of- the- art' infrastructure as well as the environment of the PMKK in which their wards are being facilitated. This process makes the Parents/Guardians one of the counsellors and also a responsible 'check' on their wards' conducts. Keeping the Parents/Guardians informed regularly makes candidates more serious and more attentive about choosing their course and career.



6. Skill Exhibitions in Catchment Areas

AISECT believes in the over all awareness and development of youth which is important for the youth in remote areas on the courses available but we offer what we have developed at AISECT PMKKs as well.

We in AISECT PMKKs have taken an initiative to organize Skill Exhibitions at different catchment areas in the districts to sensitize the youth to become Industry Ready and to make them employed. We have organized Skill Exhibitions at different locations to display the work that our enrolled candidates developed at their respective centres. These Skill Exhibitions are the showcase to the developed senses of the candidates after the trainings.
