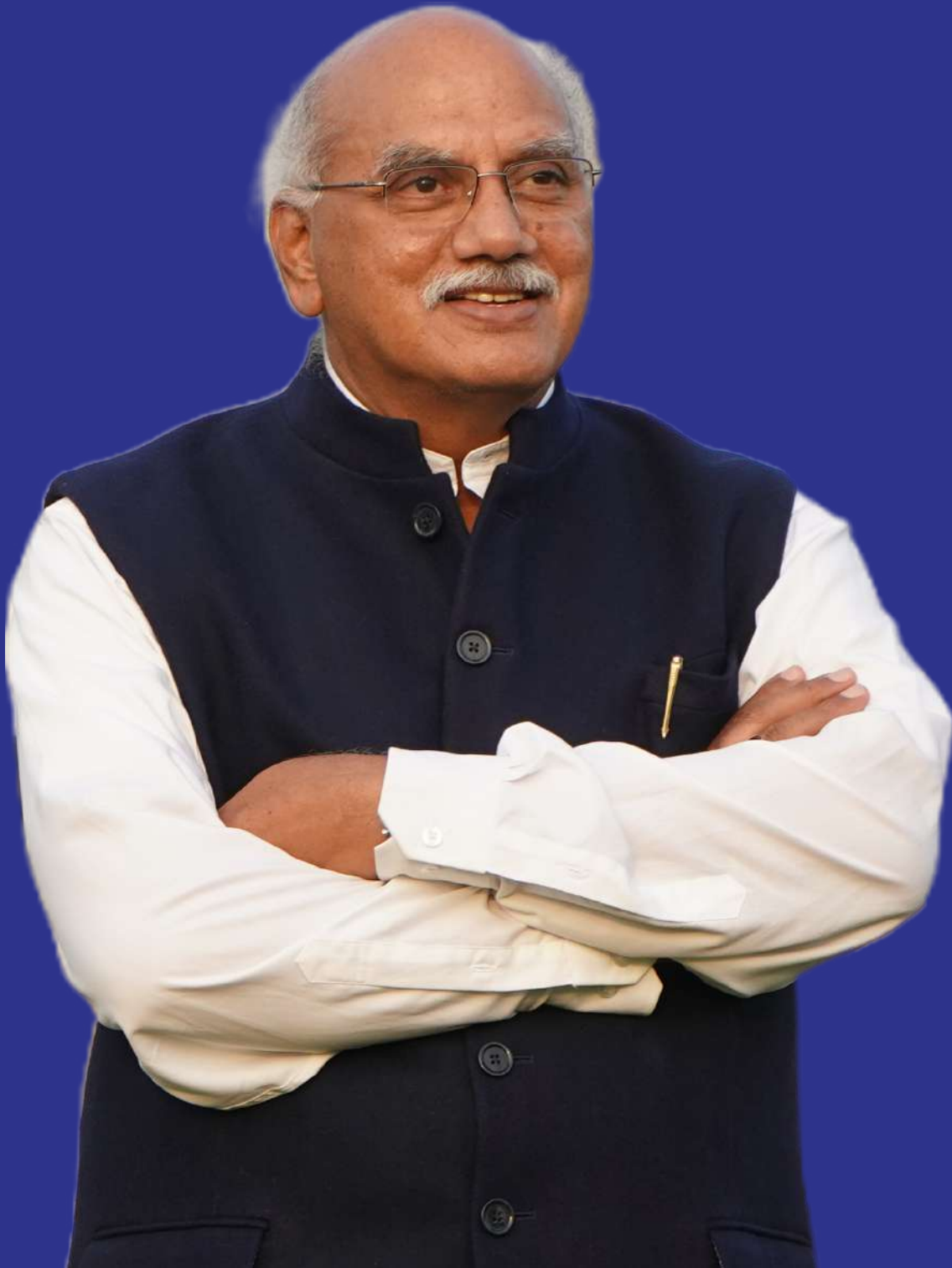

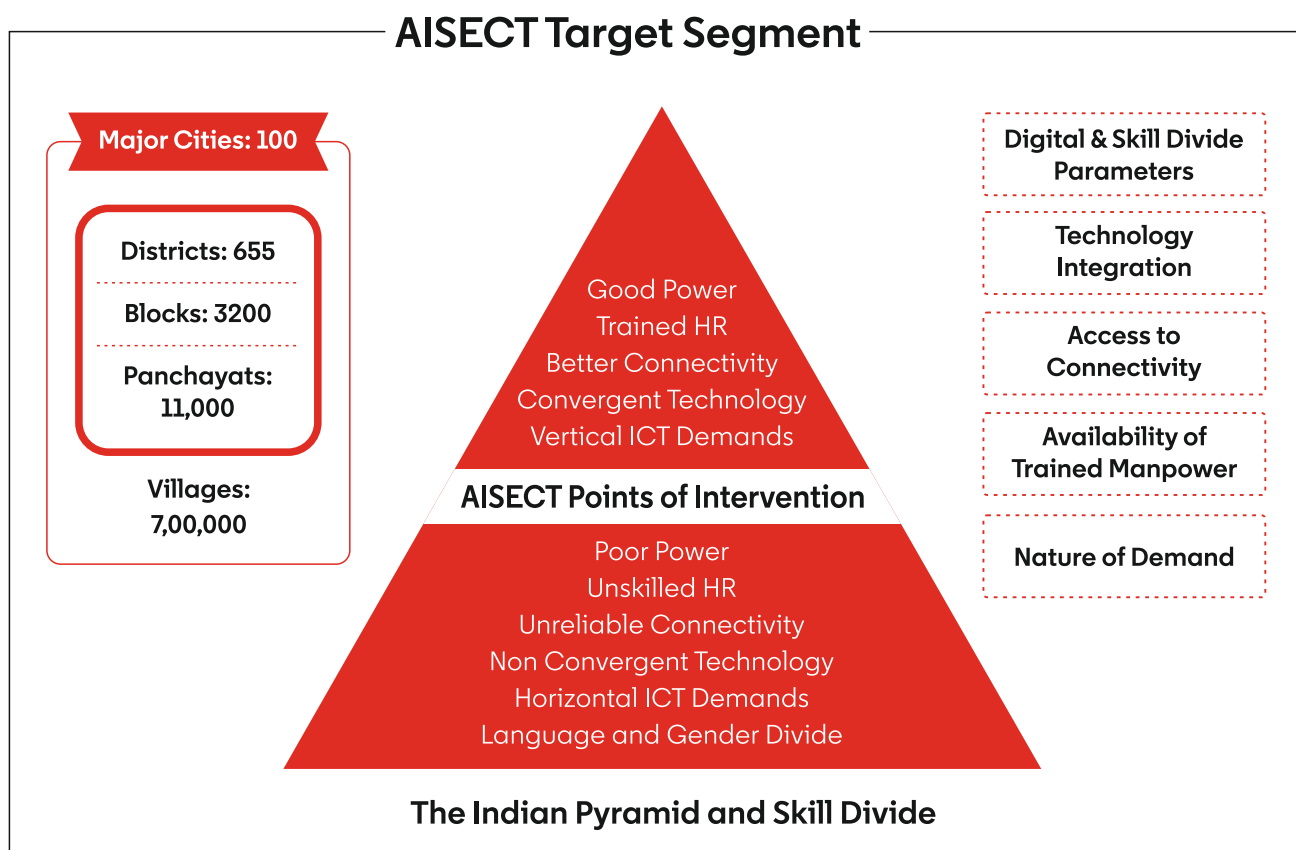

## The Foundation: 41 Years of Quiet Revolution

What began as a mission to spread digital literacy in Hindi in rural Central India has evolved through deliberate, organic growth into one of India's most powerful grassroots level network.

The journey mirrors India's own transformation: from education-led beginnings, to a broad social enterprise, to today's role as a national channel for opportunity. At every stage, AISECT has moved in response to what communities actually needed not what was convenient to deliver.

The Multipurpose ICT Centre model of AISECT was innovative making each centre multi-functional (skill development, financial services, e-governance, content, insurance). AISECT ensured that rural entrepreneurs could generate sustainable livelihoods while communities received a comprehensive basket of services at a single trusted window.



## People: Balancing Service and Scale

aisectindia's greatest competitive asset has always been its people. Deeply service-oriented, rooted in communities, motivated by purpose—they represent the human expression of the pipe.

In 2025–26, aisectindia takes deliberate steps to complement this service orientation with a profit mindset. Not as a departure from values, but as an extension of them. Because without financial sustainability, even the most purposeful organisation cannot scale its impact.

### Culture Reset: From Silos to Shared Purpose

## The Road Ahead: aisectindia@2030

The context for aisectindia's next decade is defined by three converging forces: India's Viksit Bharat ambition, the explosive expansion of Government and CSR programmes in skilling, digital inclusion and financial access, and the rise of digital-physical hybrid delivery as the dominant model for last-mile services.

aisectindia is uniquely positioned to lead at this intersection. The Network is built. The trust is earned. What remains is to expand it horizontally and penetrate deeply across the Blocks and Panchayats.

## Major verticals of aisectindia creating sustainable Enterprises

**Skill development and specialised courses** in Skill development and specialised courses in partnership with Universities and education industry leaders, AISECT has 28 academies offering nearly 200 courses aligned to the National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF), providing integrated components such as soft skills and computer skills.

**AISECT Learn is a future-ready e-learning platform.** Designed for upskilling and knowledge building that enables learners to master in-demand, industry-ready skills, delivered in Hindi and English, in a wide array of disciplines from recognised world-class universities. The learning modules are aligned with the government's New Education Policy, offering 1,000-plus courses across more than 80 categories.



**AISECT publications and its content** aims to meet the continuously evolving need for high-quality content for skills ecosystem. AISECT Content Development Group of highly qualified faculty, SMEs, researchers and developers with rich industry and practical experience offer world-class content as part of a series of uniquely designed courses from our own academy programmes, as well as courses from NSQF-aligned job roles, through which participants gain a comprehensive understanding of job roles. AISECT has also published content in the fields of Hindi literature, preschool books, and books on legal literacy, covering all sector of teaching, learning and education.

**AISECT Seva Kendra is a one-stop window.** Integrated with government departments, private business houses and other organisations to provide services in the field of academics, recruitment, online counselling, online assessment examinations and B2C services. AISECT Seva Kendra currently delivers its services through a wide network of over 26,500 centres; its aim is to make digital services permanently accessible to the ordinary citizen in his or her locality, through an integrated and affordable service delivery platform, ensuring efficiency, transparency and reliability.

**The National Electronic Toll Collection System (NETC).** Enables users to travel across national highways through toll gates without stopping using the RFID tag. Through its vast network, AISECT Ltd has tied up with SBI and has been working on this project since 2016. As of now, AISECT has enabled well over 20,00,000 vehicles to be tagged.

**Financial Inclusion aimed at extending hassle-free savings, loan facilities and other banking services** loan facilities and other banking services at an affordable cost to the underprivileged and unbanked population of the country through nationalised banks like State Bank of India, Bank of India, Bank of Baroda, Central Bank, Indian Bank, Union Bank of India, and also works Business Correspondent for Madhyanchal Grameen Bank, Chhattisgarh Gramin Bank, Uttarakhand Gramin Bank across a vast network of 7,000 banking kiosks.

Under the Social Empowerment category, AISECT was honoured in Taiwan for its responsible business leadership and community-centric development model.

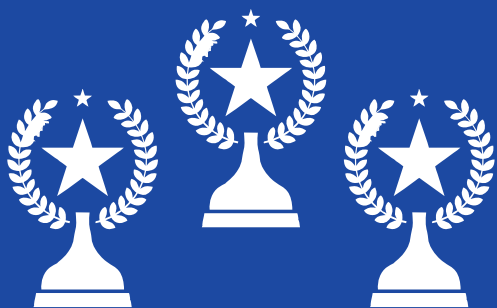
## Awards and Accolades

### NASSCOM IT Innovation Award 2006



AISECT was conferred the prestigious NASSCOM IT Innovation Award at the NASSCOM Global Leadership Forum by the late Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam. Emerging as the only organisation from Central India among 136 entries, this recognition celebrated AISECT's pioneering work in developing ICT-based content and service delivery models for rural and tribal communities.



### Golden Icon National e-Governance Award 2006



AISECT was honoured with the Golden Icon in National e-Governance for exemplary contribution in ICT promotion, dissemination of digital tools, and support to governance systems in rural India.

### NASSCOM Emerge 50 Leader Award 2009

Declared among India's Top 10 Emerging Leaders, AISECT was recognized for its unique market positioning, steady growth trajectory, and scalable innovation in technology-led inclusion.



## Manthan Award South Asia & Asia Pacific 2012

AISECT won the prestigious Manthan Award in the “E-Financial Inclusion & Livelihood” category, selected from 470 entries across South Asia. This award validated AISECT's ability to combine technology with livelihood creation.



## Bihar Innovation Forum Award

On the occasion of the second Bihar Innovation Forum, Chief Minister Nitish Kumar honoured AISECT on behalf of the Government of Bihar for developing innovative, high impact and rural solutions in ICT. Launched in April 2013, the Bihar Innovation Forum is a one-of-its-kind initiative jointly taken by Jeevika (Bihar Rural Livelihoods Promotion Society) and the World Bank, which awards social innovators who have developed impactful rural enterprises across India.

## National CSI Award for Excellence in IT

AISECT won the prestigious National CSI 2011 Award for Excellence in I.T. for its initiatives in human resource development through education. The national award, which included a cash prize of Rs. 1 lakh, was announced during the 46th Annual CSI Convention held in Ahmedabad and has been instituted by the Computer Society of India to acknowledge and motivate innovation and indigenous development in the field of Computer Science and Technology. # Financial Inclusion Banking The Unbanked

Financial inclusion has been one of the most transformative socio economic initiatives undertaken in India over the past two decades. Recognising that access to financial services is a critical driver of economic empowerment, the Government of India introduced a comprehensive **Financial Inclusion Policy in 2006** to extend banking, credit, insurance and pension services to underserved communities.

The policy sought to bridge the financial gap in rural and previously unbanked regions through **affordable, technology-enabled financial services**, including savings accounts, remittances, insurance coverage, pension schemes and credit facilities. To expand banking outreach beyond traditional branch networks, the **Reserve Bank of India introduced the Business facilitator (BF) and Business Correspondent (BC) model**, allowing banks to partner with organisations capable of delivering financial services in remote and underserved areas.

AISECT emerged as one of the pioneering organization supporting this national mission by leveraging its extensive rural ICT network and community based service delivery model being an active implementor of the Common Service Centre (CSC) project.

## The Financial Inclusion Opportunity

Despite significant expansion in India's banking infrastructure, large segments of the population particularly in rural and semi-urban areas have historically remained outside the formal financial system. Earlier estimates indicated that:

- Over **145 million households lacked access to formal banking services**
- Only **55% of the population had deposit accounts**
- Less than **9% had access to formal credit**
- Less than **20% had life insurance coverage**
- Rural India had approximately **one bank branch serving more than 14,000 people**

These structural gaps created an urgent need for innovative delivery mechanisms capable of extending financial services efficiently to remote communities.

Technology enabled models such as **Business Correspondent networks, digital banking platforms and banking kiosks** emerged as effective solutions for bridging the last mile gap between banks and rural citizens.

AISECT responded to this opportunity by leveraging its nationwide **network of ICT-enabled rural centres** to establish a scalable and technology driven financial inclusion ecosystem.



## Relevance and Significance of Financial Inclusion in India

Financial inclusion today stands at the centre of India's inclusive development strategy. Access to formal financial services enables individuals and households to save securely, access credit for livelihoods, protect themselves through insurance and pension schemes, and benefit from government welfare programmes.

Over the past decade, India has made remarkable progress in expanding financial access. Today, **more than 90% of adults in India have access to a bank account**, representing one of the fastest expansions of financial inclusion globally.

Government initiatives such as the **Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana (PMJDY)** have played a pivotal role in this transformation. By 2025, more than **55 crore Jan Dhan accounts had been opened**, bringing millions of previously unbanked citizens into the formal financial system.

Financial inclusion has also become central to India's digital governance framework through the **JAM Trinity—Jan Dhan, Aadhaar and Mobile** which enables **Direct Benefit Transfers (DBT)** of government welfare schemes directly into beneficiaries' bank accounts. This system has significantly improved transparency, reduced leakages, and ensured that financial support reaches intended beneficiaries efficiently.

In addition to strengthening welfare delivery, financial inclusion contributes to broader development outcomes, including:

- Promoting a **culture of savings and financial security**
- Expanding access to **formal credit for entrepreneurs and farmers**

AISECT has developed one of India's most extensive **technology-enabled Business Correspondent networks**, enabling banks to extend financial services to the last mile.

AISECT Network through its nationwide network of **Customer Service Points (CSPs)** has established a community driven model that combines technology, entrepreneurship and financial literacy.

These CSPs function as **mini-banking outlets**, providing essential banking services in rural and

underserved areas where traditional banking infrastructure was lacking.

AISECT ensures reliable and efficient financial transactions for millions of citizens by leveraging secure digital platforms, biometric authentication systems and real-time banking technologies,

AISECT's financial inclusion initiatives also promote **rural entrepreneurship and livelihood generation**, enabling CSP operators to earn sustainable incomes.

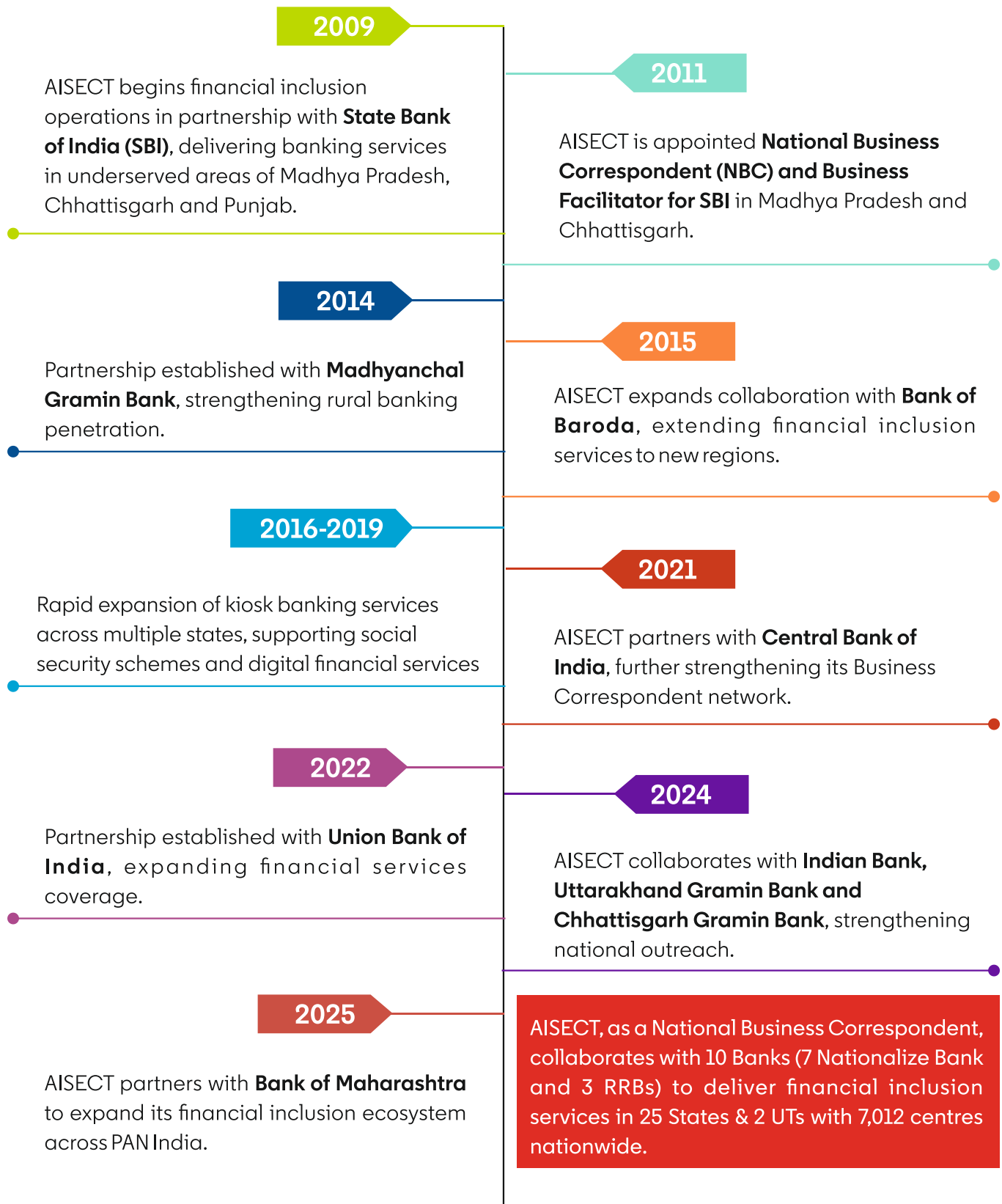

Originally launched as a quarterly publication, the magazine gradually evolved into a bi-monthly and now a monthly publication as its readership expanded and more writers began contributing from the field of Science Communication in Hindi Today, with a **circulation exceeding 40,000 copies**, the magazine reaches readers across India and is widely regarded as a reliable and engaging source of scientific information for students, educators, and technology enthusiasts.

### The Early Journey

In its initial years, Electroniki Aapke Liye when digital publishing tools wasn't widely available, the magazine was produced using **Hindi typewriters and manual type setting processes**.

The primary objective was to promote **original thinking, innovation, and scientific awareness in Hindi**, particularly for readers who were unable to access technical literature in Hindi. Workshops and discussions were organized to encourage science writing in Hindi, emphasizing that the language of science should be **simple, accessible, and engaging** even for readers with limited scientific background.

This philosophy of **science communication in accessible language** became the defining strength of the magazine and contributed significantly to its growing popularity.

The facility also includes a Chroma / Cyclorama studio for green-screen production and live streaming setup with professional switchers, broadcast cameras and audio consoles.

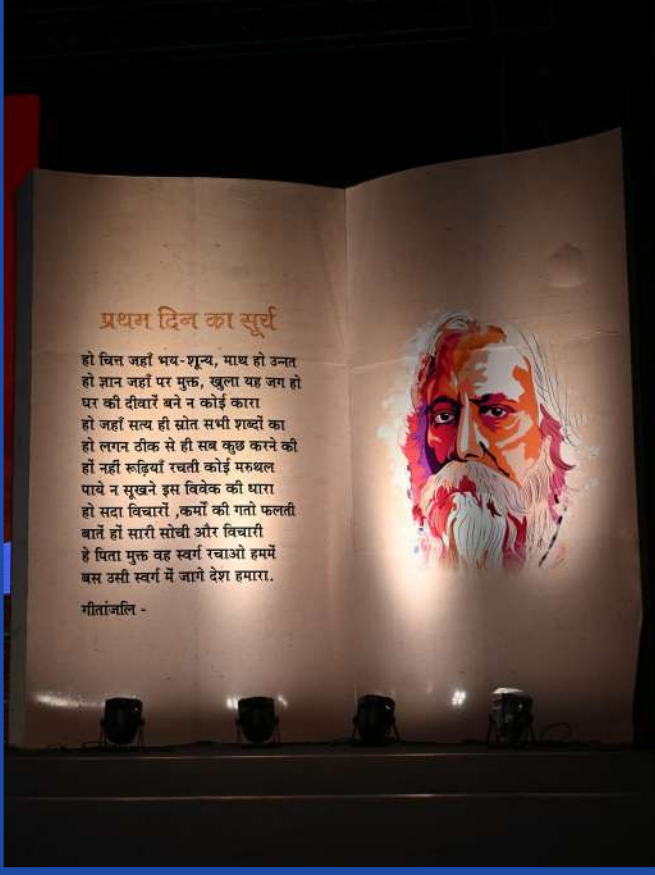
